Just Ask 2021 is ALL about accommodating growth at the



We are thrilled to announce that not only is the Academy "on the GROW," but **we have hit record numbers with nearly 100 students** attending LCA! This meant construction had to begin during the summer months to create new classroom spaces in order to accommodate separate first and second grade classes.

Although construction began this Summer in preparation for the new school year, we are putting on the finishing touches this Fall and knew in advance that this would be our Just Ask 2021 project. Your donation this year covers the expenses of building a wall that creates three new stand alone classrooms – the new second grade, the music classroom and what will be a third or fourth grade room next year. Just Ask 2021 will also pay to equip the second grade room with desks, a charging dock, TV, bulletin board, coat cubbies, etc.

- Fund the wall construction that creates THREE new classrooms including transom windows and doors (coming this Fall!).

Growth Update

- Enrolled nearly 100 students for 2021-2022!
- Separated 1st & 2nd grade classes to maintain small class size amidst growth at LCA.
- Welcomed a new 2nd grade teacher and a new Kindergarten teacher.
- Entered the final year of the dual accreditation process.
- Averaged two to three grade levels above current grade on Terra Nova scores across the Academy (*excluding students with accommodations*).
- Added an Executive Operations Assistant to coordinate student activities, administer the Dyslexia program and co-chair the accreditation steering committee.
- Launched the LCA endowment for long-term self-sustainability.
- Positioning the Academy to receive zero government dollars.
- Expanding the LCA campus with three new classrooms!
